IHSA Student Advisory Committee Nomination Form

The application process must be completed and in the IHSA office on or before January 30, 2013.

Any IHSA member school may nominate two (2) students, one freshman or sophomore male as well as one freshman or sophomore female, to be considered for this committee. The nominee must have a cumulative grade point average comparable to a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for class work completed through the first semester of his/her current year. In addition, the student must have participated in at least two IHSA sports and/or activities during each year. Finally, the student shall not have EVER been ejected from a high school contest for unsportsmanlike violations. The student must have demonstrated good sportsmanship throughout his/her high school career.
