The Following Information deserves your special attention. This bulletin has been prepared to give coaches a quick overview for the upcoming Scholastic Bowl Season. Complete information/instructions are included in the Manual for Schools in the Sport/Activity Tracker on the IHSA Website.

The most important tool for a Scholastic Bowl Coach is to have their USER ID And Password for the IHSA Schools Center to access the IHSA Sport and Activity Tracker. All IHSA requirements and deadlines for Scholastic Bowl Coaches are indicated in pink in the sport/activity tracker. Coaches have access anywhere/anytime day or night with an internet connection. Our hope is that this bulletin and the Rules Presentation will make a coaches job easier to navigate through the IHSA Scholastic Bowl Season.

I. DATES AND SITES

- A. School Entries: A.D. must enter your school to participate through IHSA Schools Center by November 1.
- B. If your school hasn't been assigned to a sectional, please contact IHSA. This is a red flag you were not entered to participate in Scholastic Bowl.
- C. Season Summary: The deadline is Friday, February 3rd at noon.
- D. Online Seeding: Online seeding will begin Tuesday, February 7th at 11:00 a.m. and will conclude February 8th at noon.
- E. Withdrawal Deadline: February 3th
- F. Regionals: Class 1A and 2A Regional tournaments will be held on Monday, March 6th
- G. Sectionals: Class 1A and 2A Sectional tournaments will be held on Saturday, March 11th
- H. State Final Tournament: Saturday, March 18
- I. Advisory Committee Mtg.: will be held May 4th.
- J. Season Ends: June 30


Coaches **must** login to the IHSA Schools Center by using their School's USER ID (5 digits, a letter followed by 4 numbers) and their Coaches Password (through instructions in an email from their high school administration).

If you haven't received this information from your School's Administration, please see them immediately (before the school year gets busy) to have this done. This is the easiest way to interact with IHSA, to meet deadlines and to keep coaches informed throughout the season.
