The room we are meeting in is at the back of the MLK Jr. University Building.

Please sit with your Officials Crew. Items discussed at the Head Officials Meeting may be discussed with the rest of the crew (procedures for the day, specific job assignments, etc.). It allows conversation about strategy for the day. During the girls State Final, we have Officials serving as officials at the Boys Track Sectionals. Some officials may be in and out during the weekend, depending on their Boys Track Sectional assignment and arrangements within each crew may need to be adjusted. Those decisions will be made by the Head Official of each crew.

Dress code for Prelims: IHSA track official uniform. Khaki or dark slacks, skirt, or shorts. Wear appropriate sun hats and glasses as well as rain gear if needed. Don't forget your Hawaii coral reef safe sunscreens and super comfortable shoes! No sport coats. No ties. I want you to be comfortable and not melt.
