### **ITEMS OF DISCUSSION:**

1. The committee heard an update on the IHSA Student Advisory Committee and the initial plans for the 2025 Student Leadership Conference.
2. Dan Le presented data on ejection and hate speech and harassment reports for the 2024-2025 school year in comparison to the 2023-2024 school year. The committee discussed the number of ejections in boys' soccer in comparison to other sports.
3. The committee continued discussions on a spectator ejection protocol and will draft language to be reviewed at the next Do What's Right! advisory committee meeting.
4. The committee discussed resources for school administrators with respect to managing interscholastic contests, including resources from the Illinois Athletic Directors Association, LTC courses, and the [IHSA](#).
5. Dan Le shared information on the Do What's Right! sportsmanship awards and number of schools registered for the Do What's Right! sportsmanship program.
6. The committee discussed player ejections and varying levels of severity in players' actions that result in a uniform penalty of a one-game suspension per IHSA by-law 6.011.
