- Establish list of officers and set meetings with defined agenda(s)
- Must have an observer's program
- Attend annual Delegate Meeting at the Summer Conference

#### **Association Benefits**

- 1. Chance to apply for grant (up to \$500)
  - Education
  - Recruiting
  - Mentoring
- 2. Opportunity for the following:
  - Submit names for IHSA awards and to become certified clinicians
  - Provide certified clinics to membership
- 3. Receive two complimentary licenses for new (first-time) officials

- Yearly opportunity for an association to help its members
  - Education
  - Recruiting
  - Mentoring
- Requests due by September 1<sup>st</sup> and reviewed by IHSA Officials Advisory Committee each year.
  - If approved, dollars are paid back to association (\$500 max) once receipts are submitted
  - Approximately \$5,000 available each year.

- Facts only...no emotionally charged language
- Be clear and concise as possible
- Once 'submit' is pressed, the report goes to the school and the IHSA Office



## Requirements

- To be listed as an active official in the Officials' Directory:
  - (if applicable) Watch rules presentation
  - Passage of Part 1 exam
  - Current Concussion training
  - Current Hate Speech & Harassment training

• While the ultimate responsibility for using only licensed, active officials rests with each member school, assignors will also want to monitor the status of those officials they've already 'assigned'.
