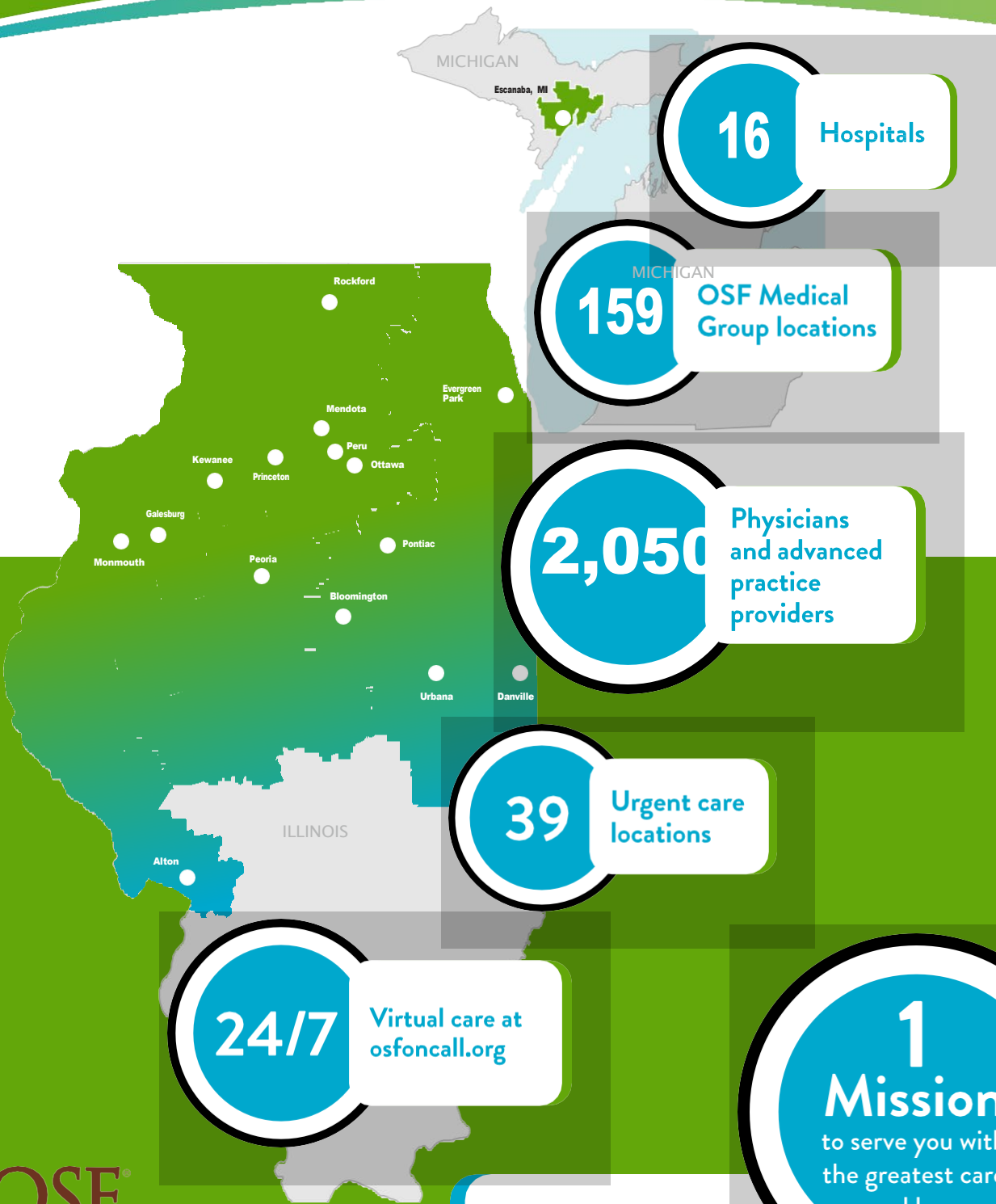

ALCOHOL AND ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES PROHIBITED

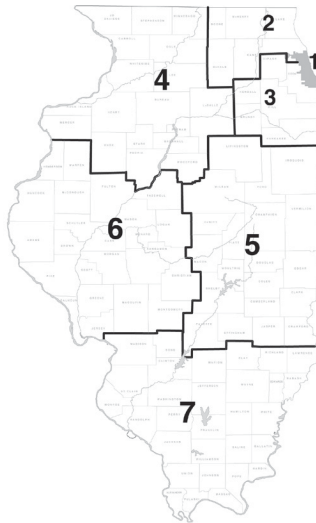

Address: 101 S. Madison Street, Bloomington, IL 61701

Tickets: Digital Tickets will be on sale through ticketmaster.com

Alcohol: Alcoholic beverages may not be brought into the building.

Food & Drinks: No outside food or beverages are allowed to be brought inside the Arena.

Video: Video of the competition will be available for purchase in the concourse.

Cameras: For competitor safety, we ask that no flash be used during competition.

Containers: Bottles, cans, coolers, or other plastic containers are specifically prohibited from the Arena.

Patron Conduct: Patrons using foul language or appearing to be in a drunken condition may be ejected from the Arena. If someone is interfering with the enjoyment of others, please contact guest services immediately. Noisemakers and confetti are prohibited from the Arena.

First Aid: In the event of illness or injury, contact any Arena employee immediately, or go to the first aid room located behind Section 105 on the Concourse.
